### SATs

### HOMEWORK

We really appreciate home support around the importance of the completion of any homework set and for engaging in home reading.

We encourage children to read as widely as possible including their school reading book of which the school has a large variety to choose from.

The expectation is for children to read 5 times a week to develop their confidence, fluency and understanding.

### BOOSTER SESSIONS

In view of the amount of lost learning that the children have experienced since March 2020, we are running catch up boosters to support lost learning and promote children's confidence and ensure that they are on track for progression to Secondary education and the next part of their learning journey.

Booster sessions take place on a Tuesday (Maths) and a Thursday (Reading) both before and straight after school. All children are welcome and actively encouraged to attend one of each of the sessions. It would be fabulous if all children could attend
