As Musicians we will:

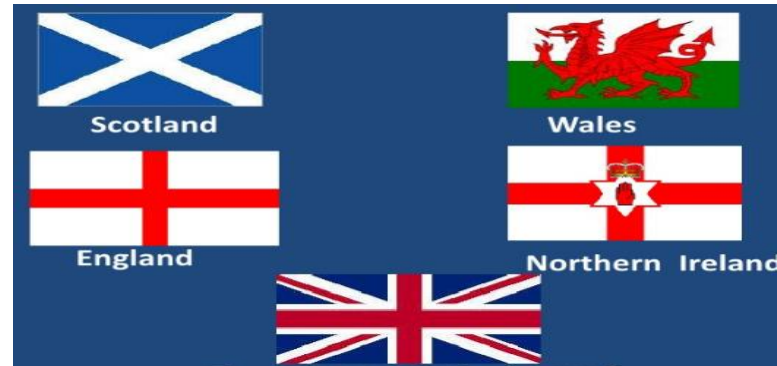
- Learn about Elgar's Pomp & Circumstance March No. 1 - why was it written, in what situations is it now used (BBC Proms, sports, films)
