### **SATs Meeting:**

During the week commencing Monday 13<sup>th</sup> May, Year 6 SATs will take place for all children in Year 6.

These national tests are compulsory for all children in Year 6 and the results are shared with the children's secondary school.

We are holding an information session in school on Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> March at 5pm for parents to meet with the year 6 team and ask any questions.

**Walking Talking SATs w/c 4<sup>th</sup> March** - This will be following the May SATs timetable and children will be sitting in the rooms with the adults that will be with them during SATs week.

### **Booster Sessions:**

In preparation for the SATs testing and to support children's transition to secondary school we have been running booster sessions in school.

**These are:** Tuesday am - 8am - 8.45am - Maths

Tuesday pm - 3.15pm - 4pm - Maths

Thursday am - 8am - 8.45am - English

Thursday pm - 3.15pm - 4pm - English

It would be absolutely amazing if each child would attend 1 of the sessions each day. This would help our children to build confidence by revisiting and revising key concepts and give them the opportunity to develop lost techniques and to receive additional support.

It is our dearest wish that each of our pupils leave Oakfield Primary as the very best version of themselves, both academically and personally with high self-esteem, confidence and the ability to cope with the change ahead.

Last year our children did exceptionally well and produced some outstanding results, some of the best in our local authority.

### **Transition to Secondary School:**

Please can we remind parents that they should have completed the application forms for a place at the secondary school they wish their child to attend.

The local authority will contact you to confirm your place. Your chosen secondary school will contact you to discuss transition arrangements during the Summer Term.

**Parents evening:** Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> February and Thursday 29<sup>th</sup> February

**A reminder of FSM** - This will transfer to your secondary provider.

This information about free school meals applies to children who attend schools in North Lincolnshire. Free school meals are offered to children of families who receive one of the following:

- Universal Credit with an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400
- Income Support

- Income-based Job Seekers Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guarantee element of Pension Credit
- Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for the four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
- Child Tax Credit (with no Working Tax Credit) with an annual income of no more than £16,190

If your child qualifies for free school meals you may also receive a [school clothing grant](#). We will assess this at the same time as your free school meals claim, using the same application.

**How to apply**

Please list all of your children who attend a school in North Lincolnshire on the form.

It may also enable us to pay you a clothing grant and the school will receive up to an extra £1,320 per year from the Government for each of your children.
