As Historians we will:

- Learn about why the Anglo-Saxons and Vikings came to Britain.
- Discover the importance of the Viking raid on Lindisfarne.
- Find out how Alfred the Great introduced monarchy to Britain.
- Identify Anglo-Saxon and Viking settlements in the local area

As Musicians we will:

- Appreciate and understand music from a different culture.
- Order, combine and control sounds to create an effect.
- Use ostinato and call and response within composition.
- Perform with control and awareness of others.

As Scientists we will:

- Understand the differences between solids, liquids and gases.
- Set up a practical enquiry to investigate the change of state during evaporation.
- Know how to use a classification key to help group living things.
- Explore the changes and dangers in our local habitat.

As Designers and Artists, we will:

- Mould and add materials using clay.
- Explore texture and colour convey feelings and expression.
- Know how to prepare ingredients hygienically using appropriate utensils.

In French, we will:

- Discuss likes and dislikes.
- Know and repeat vocabulary related to hobbies (dance, swim, play football etc).
