- Explain the importance and impact of local historical figures.
- Investigate the development of Scunthorpe United.
- Understand the role that local people played during WW1

As Musicians we will:

- Compare music from the WW1 period
- Describe and appraise music including: pitch, dynamics, tempo, timbre, texture
- Identify beat and rhythm, melodic patterns and leaps, smooth phrases and changing dynamics within music.
- Sing from memory with confidence and in tune.
- Select elements for a piece to gain a desired effect.
- Describe how lyrics often reflect the cultural context of music and have social meaning

As Scientists we will:

- Compare the properties of different materials.
- Test and examine materials that are insulators and conductors.
- Understand that some materials have properties that are suited to different roles.
- Understand that some materials will dissolve in liquid to form a solution.
- Investigate the dissolving process and how different materials may affect this process.
- Investigate how to separate a substance from a solution.
- Understand that dissolving, mixing

- Use research to inform our own ideas and plans.
